They joined 14 people from

Barbados and many Grenadines to reach the people of Grenada through Operation Andrew. Teams of two to four Americans along with two or three Barbadians and three or more Grenadines were assigned to six different Baptist churches in Grenada where they worked all week. Teams went out each day to share the love and message of Jesus Christ with men, women, boys, girls, and students. Many of the
