Today is Passover and today we will celebrate the Lord's Supper in worship. There is a wonderful and important continuum from Passover to the cross and



people of God. It is an act of worship in which the believer enters into the experience of the Lord's sacrifice and promises of redemption. In the supper we "taste and see that the Lord is good." It is a service of the senses: a moment to meditate, touch, taste, and smell the grace of God.

As we spoke last week, worship spans more than an hour, it spans the ages. It unites us with the saints of the past and the angels of heaven as we gather before the throne of God. Perhaps like no other time, the service of the Lord's Supper presents the opportunity for our unity through the ages. Every church, from the first one in Jerusalem and throughout the ages, has taken the simple symbols of wine and bread handed down by our Lord. Luther, Calvin, Augustine, C. S. Lewis, C. H. Spurgeon, my dad, granddad, and your believing relatives all have entered into the simple but profound experience of faith and worship.

This morning we join them before the throne of God. We worship

Still the Lord's Supper is not for everyone. Those who are not of faith, who have not yet followed the Lord in believer's baptism, are not to participate in the Lord's Supper. To do so would be meaningless to you. There is no magic nor is there meaning in the Supper for the one who does not have a faith relationship with Jesus.

If you are a parent of a child who has yet to make a profession of faith, do not allow them to take the elements of the Supper as if they are a church snack. To do so makes the elements meaningless to them. Instead, use the time to instruct them in faith. Allow the Holy Spirit to use this time as a time of teaching, drawing, and even convicting in their lives.

Enter His gates with thanksgiving, And His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him; bless His name. For the LORD is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting, And His faithfulness to all generations. (Psalm 100:4-5)
