# Media Ministry reaches **Upper Cumberland**

First Baptist Church was a pioneer in the field of church television broadcast. Beginning in 1973, the church has continued the live broadcast of weekly worship services until today. These programs reach homes throughout the Upper Cumberland. Since the advent of cable television, the audience of the First Baptist television ministry constantly grows with the expansion of the local cable provider.

In addition to broadcasting the Sunday worship services, the media minis-



try crew also provides support for every event held in the church's sanctuary. These volunteers lend their technical expertise to a variety of events such us Upward Awards Night, revivals, training events, and musicals. The media crew currently consists of 26 volunteers. They are coordinated by Nelson Chancy who serves as chairman of the media ministry committee. Media Director Mike Casey is a part-time staff member who provides technical support

and training to this active ministry team.

A crew of nine volunteers works at each televised event. These nine positions include a director, a television sound operator, a sanctuary sound operator, three camera operators, a sanctuary lighting operator, a projectionist, and a television graphics operator. Crew members are scheduled to work at least twice a month. The crew is always looking for new members in each of the positions listed above. Training is provided. For more information simply speak with one of the crew members on duty today.

Associate Pastor/Music Jonathan Nelms is directly responsible for the media ministry at First Baptist. He observes, "Almost every week I meet

someone in our community who watches our television broadcast, but does not attend church. This is an open door for me to invite them to First Baptist. I also hear from folks who cannot attend church but regularly watch our worship services on television. This is an important ministry to people throughout the Upper Cumberland. It is a joy to recognize the faithful service of our media crew. Truly, God has blessed First Baptist with the vision and resources to continue this unique ministry in Putnam County."


