Do you 'go to worship', 'attend worship', or simply 'worship'. It's a good personal evaluation to make. Some people 'go to' or 'attend worship' all of their lives. They are 'in worship' but do they 'worship'? It is an important distinction. How can you evaluate your place in worship? Here are some good evaluating questions:

- 1) After your worship experience was your conversation focused upon the scripture presented and its application to your life or of the way it was presented?
- 2) During your worship experience did you focus upon praying, singing, and listening to God's word or did you focus on other people, other times, or other places?
- 3) During your worship experience were you intent upon knowing God or getting from God a solution to your problem, an answer to your question, or a fix to your relationship?
- 4) Before worship did you take time intentionally to prepare your heart for worship or did you just walk in and sit down?

Worship is not built for our entertainment but for the praise and glory of God. Yes, we can and do find solutions to problems, healing for relationships, forgiveness of sin, and a host of other personal benefits in the context of worship. But we miss these benefits when we are intent upon finding "them" instead of seeking God. Too many, too often focus on self too much and focus upon God too little in worship.

I challenge you to change the atmosphere of your life. Stop 'going to', 'attending', or 'being in' worship. Instead, come and worship in the midst of God's people. God is here and He wants deeply to reveal Himself to you.
