Many ways you can be involved with Vacation Bible School

It's almost time for Vacation Bible School! Workers are saddling up for *Saddle Ridge Ranch VBS* June 21-25 from 9:00 a.m. to noon. Assist children as they round up questions like What is God's Plan for Me? and How Can I be Like Jesus? and discover that all the answers are in God's word.

Opportunities abound for you to invest in children during this week. Teachers are still needed in some areas. If you can be here for a few hours, one day, or the whole week, please contact Ann Hertzfeldt and get plugged in.

Can't be here during the week, but still want to be involved? Participate in an outreach blitz on Wednesday, June 16 from 6:00-7:30 p.m. We'll visit neighborhoods around the church and hand out invitations to VBS. TeamKID will use this as an outreach time, going out with invitations and then coming back for a snack. Parents will be needed to assist with this outreach project.

During the evening service on Sunday, June 20 we will celebrate the Lord's Supper and then do a VBS Prayer Walk throughout the church. Participants will spend time praying over rooms and praying for teachers, leaders and children. VBS workers are encouraged to participate in this special time. Please keep all the VBS teachers and staff and children attending VBS in your prayers throughout the week.

The VBS missions offering will also make an impact in the lives of children. The offering will be split between Evangelistic Children's Programs in India and the Mustard Seed Ranch. The Evangelistic Children's Programs are like a backyard Bible club, presenting the gospel to Muslim, Hindu, Buddhist and Christian families using a flip chart. Before the gospel is presented, children gather for games and songs and then enjoy a snack and craft after the gospel presentation. The cost of these programs is about \$.50 per child.

The Mustard Seed Ranch serves children who have been neglected, abused, orphaned or in need of a loving family environment. Children are offered hope as they are provided healing through spiritual, emotional, intellectual and physical support. The ranch currently houses 14 boys and girls.

As always, you can minister to VBS teachers and staff by bringing finger foods, cookies or chips and a 2-liter drink to the kitchen one day during the week. Please have these here by no later than 9:00 a.m.

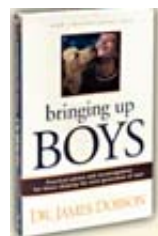
