We praise the Lord that not only were people fed and clothed but so far this year 46 individuals have indicated that they have trusted Christ for salvation. The Center is open on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from noon to 2:00 pm and volunteers are always needed and appreciated. Your food and baby item donations can be made here at First Baptist or carried to the Care Center located on Short Street. Continue to pray that God will use this ministry to share the Gospel through ministering to those less fortunate in our community.


