# Pastor's Heart

Three words — Encounter, Encourage, Engage have labeled our goals as a congregation. We are to encounter God in worship, encourage one another in discipleship, and engage in the mission and ministry of the Kingdom.

In these days we are focusing on our engagement. We are particularly focusing on God's mission to our neighbors.

ciled with the fact that God has a plan for your life that includes your presence in your neighborhood?

I want us (as do you) to be a biblical church that embraces the fullness of God's call upon our lives. I want us (as do you) to be the church in our community. I want us (as do you) to be serious about fulfilling God's plan for us.

We must be a church in the heart of the city with the city upon our heart!
