Christmas Musical next Sunday evening

The Music Ministry of First Baptist will present a concert of Christmas music next Sunday evening, December 12, at 6:00 p.m. This annual event will feature the

Sanctuary and Chi Rho Youth Choirs as well as the FBC Orchestra and the Praise Ringers.

Jonathan Nelms who compiled the program comments, "I have entitled the program 'Welcome the Child of Light' because it is a celebration of the Light of Christ overcoming the darkness of this world. The Sanctuary Choir will sing a song by this title and many of the other songs reinforce this theme of light shining in the midst of darkness."

The Sanctuary Choir will also sing a rousing gospel tune by Andre Thomas called "Walk in the Light" and a stately arrangement by John Rutter entitled "Rejoice and Be Merry." This choir of students and adults will also present Pepper Choplin's poignant anthem "Waiting" just before a short inspirational word from Pastor Randy.

The Chi Rho Youth Choir will present four songs during the program: a Latin styled "Bethlehem Proces-

sion," Handel's magnificent "For Unto Us a Child Is Born," and Chris Tomlin's worshipful "Uncreated One." Chi Rho will also repeat an arrangement of "Silent Night" which they presented last year. This setting will include soloists singing the popular carol in German, Spanish, and Korean. The youth boys will sing a foundational ostinato in Zulu throughout the piece as well.

In addition to great choral music, our church instrumentalists will also be featured. The First Baptist Church Orchestra will play a lush setting of "What Child Is This" and a driving arrangement of Michael W. Smith's "Emmanuel." Under the direction of Todd Arnold, the Praise Ringers Handbell Team will play a delightful medley of "Joy to the World" and "How Great Our Joy."

The program will conclude with a bombastic setting of "Hark! The Herald Angels Sing" for combined choir, orchestra, handbells, and congregation. Sanctuary Choir President Robert Fuller observes, "This program has something for everyone. It is an eclectic mix of favorite carols and new songs in a variety of styles."

Everyone who attends the program will be invited to a Christmas Tasting Party following the concert. Linda Sharpe is coordinating the set-up and décor for this annual extravaganza of food and fellowship. More details are available in the Central Lobby.

Nursery service will be provided for the concert. No tickets are necessary, but the Sanctuary typically fills before the program begins. Jonathan adds, "I hope our church members will invite their family, friends, and especially their neighbors to this special Christmas event. It is a great time to meet new friends and introduce them to the Lord."
