Pastor's Heart

New Year's brings new opportunities! As we come to the end of 2010 and begin fresh 2011 we do so with several clear truths from God.

1) God is at work in your life. The scriptures plainly state "He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus." (Phil. 1:6) So, you and I both can be assured that God is actively in-

volved and working in our lives.

You are a wonderful sculpture in progress. That may mean that there is still some chisel work to be done. Or maybe God is in the polishing stage with you. Either way, God is working to make you a beautiful reflection of His grace. Romans 8:29 states, "For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son."

2) God wants to use you this year to make a difference in His church and it's mission. "God has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity." (2 Tim. 1:9)

God can grow you and use you more in the times of testing than in any other time in your life. The soldier is a soldier every day, but the times of battle are when he/she is really grown and used.

So we begin a new year. Pray and prepare to be all that God desires. Be faithful in your worship, your mission, and in your stewardship. Remember to "Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight." (Prov. 3:5-6)
