

Pastor's Heart

"Whiter than snow. Yes, whiter than snow!" The hymn writer penned in reference to the words of the Psalm: "Purify me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; Wash me, and I shall be whiter than

Isaiah reveals an even more wonderful truth: "Come now, and let us reason together," Says the LORD, "Though your sins are as scarlet, They will be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They will be like wool." (Is. 1:18)

These wonderful words tell us of the effectual nature of Jesus' sacrifice and remind us of today's focus, as well. Paul writes, "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me." (Gal. 2:20)

I pray that as you looked upon the lingering snow this week that you meditated upon God's great love for you and Jesus' effectual sacrifice for your sins. Now as God looks upon you, in Christ, you are cleansed and accepted.

This week's snow challenges also remind me of one of our mission trip maxims: "Blessed are the flexible, for they shall not be bent out of shape."

When it comes to winter weather I pray that you are flexible and understand the difficulties involved in managing the schedules and ministries of our church. When considering an adjustment to scheduling we have to take into account things like food preparation times, the danger of accidents for our congregation, whether we

will have volunteers to staff our programs, and many other similar factors. After considering all of these things, sometimes, reluctantly, the best solution is to cancel services, especially those that are held after dark. Thanks for your flexibility in understanding these things.

What we never cancel is our morning services. We have held joint Sunday School for whoever shows (sometimes simply taking those who arrived and asking them to man the phone lines). We always strive to have and broadcast the morning worship, realizing we are reaching more by television on 'snow days' than regularly.

So, thanks to everyone who has made special efforts over the last number of weeks to lead musically, provide sound and video, teach a Sunday School class, work with children, or feed the hungry on difficult days. May your work be rewarded with wonderful blessings from our Savior.



Upward and Devoted seasons underway

The Upward Basketball and Cheerleading and Devoted Basketball seasons tipped off Friday, January 8 and Saturday, January 9 with full slate of games. Games started Friday night at 5:30 p.m. with the last game starting at 8:30 p.m. On Saturday games began at 8:00 a.m. with kindergarten and the 5th-6th grade boys capped off the night with a game starting at 7:00 p.m. Five Devoted games were also played at Avery Trace on Saturday afternoon.

Despite the snow, the gym was packed with an estimated 1,700 people coming through the Family Life Center during the weekend. Each of those folks heard about the expectations of Upward and Devoted from members of the leadership

team. Now each person that enters the gym on Friday night or Saturday has the opportunity to hear the gospel as volunteers give devotionals at halftime of each game.

The number of participants has soared this season with 405 children compiling 48 Upward Basketball teams and 11 cheer squads. Devoted Basketball has around 150 youth making up 17 teams. This growth has caused us to stretch beyond our gym to

fit in games. Devoted teams are playing at Avery Trace in addition to FBC.

Serving each of these children, youth and their families with excellence takes the work of many faithful volunteers who are willing to do "Whatever It Takes." These folks show Jesus' love as they help children grow spiritually and physically while teaching them about basketball and cheerleading.

Children grow spiritually through scripture learning and devotions at practice each week. Devoted players have weekly devotions at practice. Coaches provide sports instruction to each child while also investing spiritually in each child/youth. Coaches for both leagues were asked to sign a coaches covenant conveying this commitment. They were also given a cross to keep in their pocket to remind them of this commitment.

This season has brought a renewed focus on the prayer ministry. Prayer partners have been enlisted to pray for each of the teams and beyond that to send cards or come to practice or games. A prayer board, put together by prayer commissioner Deborah Baranowski, is designed to have folks stop and pray while waiting on their child's game. Bro. Randy gives Deborah a weekly prayer focus to put on the board and then the board is filled with weekly scripture verses and announcements. We still need a few prayer partners to cover each of our teams. If you are interested,




