



First Baptist engaged in missions

This season brings about a strong missions emphasis and members of First Baptist Church have been very involved in local and foreign missions over the last week.

Today we will dedicate our Operation Christmas Child boxes, which go to places all over the world, blessing children with Christ-

mas presents and the gospel of Christ. Continue to pray for the child(ren) who will receive your box.

On Saturday, November 5 and Monday, November 7, families flooded First Baptist Church for Upward Basketball and Devoted Basketball evaluations and cheerleading orientation. We evaluated 281 kids in kindergarten through 6th grade and had 40 cheerlead-

ers go through orientation while also evaluating 50 Devoted players.

Forty-four faithful volunteers made sure this first key ministry moment for our church was a quality experience. Families continue to come in and register their kids with Upward Basketball at 298 participants and cheerleading up to 41. Devoted Basketball has 64 youth registered.

On Monday, November 7, the Women on Mission group served a Thanksgiving meal to about 53 students and staff from White Plains Academy. Students played in the Family Life Center prior to and after the meal.
