Pastor's Heart

Last week we noted that "immorality" is not defined as a specific list of thoughts or actions, but immorality is the use of God's creation in a way that deviates from God's design and standard. So, for example, sex outside the boundaries of a marriage of covenant is immoral because it breaks God's design for mankind.

We also found that judgment for sin does not so much consist of God looking for someone to 'zap' because He is angry, but it more often con-

sists of the natural outcome of using our emotions and bodies in ways and for purposes for which they were not designed. When things created by God or man are used in ways for which they were not designed they break, wear out, tear up, and shut down.

So individuals, families, and churches are breaking, wearing out, tearing up, and shutting down because we are choosing to walk in paths never designed for our travel.

We can't blame God for this. He has given us our design specifications and our correct usage. Our 'systems failures' are not due to faulty design, any more than faulty design can be blamed for the crack up of a military jet that decides to nose into the ocean or the break up of a car when it careens into a tree. When things are used in ways for which they were neither designed nor built tragedy occurs.

"Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap." (Galatians 6:7)

Now, God has defeated our failures and seeks to redeem our lives. All of us have walked in some form of 'immorality'. Yet, God in His great love and mercy has paid the debt of our sin and offers us both forgiveness and restoration.

This morning we will spend time looking at God's redemption and God's plan for a redeemed life. We can walk in victory over sin. God's word will show us how.

"Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God." (1 Corinthians 6:11)

Today is a great time to rejoice, our *Proof Initiative* Studies are beginning in several homes in our first targeted neighborhoods. We are learning a great deal as we struggle through the process, and God is building us in every struggle.

Keep praying for the *Proof Initiative* and for the development of our small group studies. Pray too as we begin the development of our plan for our second targeted neighborhood this fall. Pray that God will work in your life and that God will work through your life.
