Pastor's Heart

Here is an important word for parents: "Pay Attention!" That is, pay attention to what your children are watching, and listening to. Introduce them early to quality wholesome literature and to quality music, Christian and otherwise. They will enjoy what you introduce.

I'll never forget the mother who came to me concerned that the Disney animated movies might be undermining her

Christian parenting with subliminal images or hidden meanings. Later in a casual conversation I asked her daughter, on the cusp of childhood and her teenage years, what her favorite movie was. Her answer was, "Pretty Woman."

Mom was worried about the subliminal messages of others when she should have been worried about the overt message she was sending by allowing sexually charged movies to be viewed with her approval. Children still take most of their cues from the lives of their parents.

Researchers from Dartmouth College reported the result of a six-year study on the correlation between teen sexual experimentation and exposure to sexual themes in media. The conclusion: for every hour of exposure to sexual content participants were 5 times more likely to lose their virginity within 6 years. This was not 'pornography' but the sexually charged popular fare of today's movies and TV shows.

"Adolescents who are exposed to more sexual content in movies start having sex at younger ages, have more sexual partners, and are less likely to use condoms with casual sexual partners," said Dr Ross O'Hara, who led the study... This study, and its confluence with other work, strongly suggests that parents need to restrict their children from seeing sexual content in movies at young ages."

The most important influence in the life of your child is you! Your attitudes, passions, and actions are often passed to your children and magnified in their lives. The world will influence them, but you will shape them by what you do and say (or don't do and do not say). Make sure you are showing your children what you want them to see.

Next Sunday night will be a great time to show your children the importance of your faith and actions. We will celebrate a very special Lord's Supper together around the tables of a fellowship meal. Plan to come at 6:00 p.m. and bring a covered dish or two for supper to share with your church family. We will join together around the tables for a meal, worship, and the Lord's Supper.

During the evening we will also express our appreciation to Ann Hertzfeldt for her service to our children by honoring her request to bring diapers and wipes to be donated to the Cookeville Pregnancy Clinic. Let's make it the largest mess of diapers in history!


